## The Society's Funds, Endowments and Managed Foundations

The balance sheet of the Royal Physiographic Society of Lund includes 49 entries listing reserved funds, endowments and managed foundations. All these assets are managed collectively. The foundations, which are under the supervision of the County Administrative Board of Skåne, each have a separate annual report.

A summary of the Society's reserved funds, endowments and managed foundations is given below, sorted according to the year of establishment, each with its full name and a statement of its purpose according to the provisions of the endowment.
